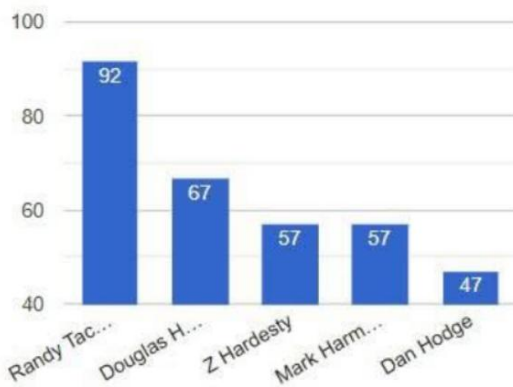
Ohio Valley Region 2025 Awards Banquet

Election Results

Results of the Election plus a surprise change to the Board or Directors.

Our election for this year has been completed, with the results being announced at our Election Socializer. The socializer was held on November 5th at Carfagna's at Polaris Parkway. A selection of wings, lasagna and meatballs were made available to members present, with a follow up of multiple styles of dessert pieces.

OVR had a total of 3 board of directors positions available. A total of 119 ballots were received with tallies from those counted to select the winners. Randy Tackett claimed the first spot with 92 Votes (2-year term). Next up, Douglas Houdeshell came in second with 67 Votes (2-year term). The results for third place were interesting, as both Z Hardesty and Mark Harmon tied with 57 votes. As per the region's bylaws, the members present at the socializer were tasked with breaking the tie. Matt Downing, our elections officer, first asked all non-members to move to a different area of the room before he went through the remaining group and verified that everyone had an SCCA ID card and that their membership was up to date. A vote was then called, and Z was selected as the winner for the third seat on the board (1-year term).

But wait, there's more!

As many of you know, Dave Brown, our elected RE, was appointed as the Area 4 director to serve the remainder of Dayle Frame's term. As such, Dave has resigned his RE position for the OVR Board. You will find his resignation letter elsewhere in this newsletter.

Per the bylaws, the acting board members voted at the December Board Meeting to select a replacement. Two members nominated themselves for the position. Z Hardesty and Dan Hodge both raised their hands and volunteered to serve out the remainder of Dave's Term. After a vote, Z Hardesty was selected as our acting RE, and while Dave is leaving, he will stick around for a bit as an Assistant RE to help Z transition to the new position.

With Dave leaving and Z stepping up as RE, we then had an open position to fill. That position goes to Mark Harmon, who had the next highest number of votes in the previous election.

Congratulations, Z, and Dave, thanks to you for the service you have provided the region as our RE!
